Following are important dates and information regarding the re-enrollment process:

- Each student currently enrolled in grades 1-7 will have a \$50 holding fee charged to their family tuition account on April 12.
- Parents must re-enroll each student through the new, streamlined, online re-enrollment process on ParentsWeb.
- Re-enrollment must be done during the period of April 12 – 27. (The portal will open at noon on Monday, 4/12.)
- During the enrollment period, parents must ensure the \$50 holding fee is paid. Payments may be dropped off at the office or paid electronically using the PayNow feature on ParentsWeb.
- The \$50 holding fee is considered pre-paid tuition for each returning child. Tuition charges posted in July for the 2010-2011 school year will reflect this pre-payment.
- Failure to pay the \$50 holding fee for each student by April 30 will result in a \$50 late registration fee which will be charged to your family account.
- Holding fees and additional registration fees are non-refundable.
- Parents must notify St. Patrick School by April 30, 2010 if their student will not be returning next year. Upon notification, the \$50 holding fee will be reversed from accounts. Failure to notify school administration by the deadline will result in a \$50 per student Failure to Notify Penalty and parents will be liable in full.

Our RenWeb system will continue to track Tuition, Cafeteria and Misc. Fees Accounts. Please remember, parents are responsible for checking account balances and ensuring no balances are due.

Monday, April 12 at NOON and close Sunday, April 27 at MIDNIGHT

Charges will begin posting to family RenWeb Tuition Accounts beginning 7/1/2010. The amount charged will be based on the agreed tuition payment plan selection. All families must select from the above plans and are subject to all applicable finance charges and plan fees. Any plan change requests are subject to \$25 fee. These fees are new for the 2010-2011 school year and will be strictly enforced to help cover the additional administrative cost of managing past due accounts and special requests. Statements will be emailed on 7/1/10 to all school families. Please ensure the school has your current email address. Families are solely responsible for checking their financial account balances throughout the year by accessing their ParentsWeb account via renweb.com.

In addition to tuition, each child will be charged a classroom supply fee which is due at the beginning of the school year. Throughout the course of the year, there will be other charges, including but not limited to field trip and project fees. These charges will be posted to the family MISCELLANEOUS FEE ACCOUNT and are due at the time of posting. Each family also has a CAFETERIA ACCOUNT for school lunch and milk. CAFETERIA ACCOUNTS must be prepaid in order for students to receive school lunch and milk. Our school participates in the National School Lunch Program which offers Free and Reduced Lunch for qualifying families. Families are responsible for checking their account balances for all three accounts online via ParentsWeb and ensuring all balances are paid in full. Past due accounts will be charged a 1% finance fee on the 15th of each month for any outstanding balances.
